### TREA Chapter 58 Celebrates 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary

TREA Chapter 58 began its organization at a small table in the corner of the MacDill Enlisted Club in March 1988. TREA chartered the Tampa Bay Chapter 58 on March 16, 1988 with only 13 retirees enlisted members. Election and installation of the first board of directors was in March 16.1989 by TREA National President George Canes. 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice Blondet prepared the chapter by-laws and incorporated Chapter 58 meetings are held the chapter with the FL. > However, over the years our membership has dropped to around 287 at the present time and this was due to members moving out of state, death and medical problems which have led to a small number of members taking over the job of keeping the Chapter going year to year. With no new members coming into the Chapter and no new members stepping up to join our Board of Directors it is getting harder and harder to keep the Chapter going much longer.

.Our Chapter has participated in the AirFest

events at MacDill for many years, the Retirees Appreciation Day at MacDill, and many of our members have worked with Veteran Organizations in our community. Chapter 58 has donated to several organizations that deal with military veterans in the Tampa Bay Area. We also have a JROTC program with several high schools in our area as well where we give a chosen cadet a certificate, medal and a cash donation for that school each year. 1st VP Leonard Black has been working with the Honor Flight of West Centeral Florida.

Our Chapter has had a Newsletter, The Trooper, from the beginning, which has now been put onto our Website with the Veterans Post News. Secretary Juanita Anspach, who has been a member from the beginning of Chapter 58, has been the editor of the newsletter for most of the 25 years. This has made it possible for all of our members to know what the Chapter was doing and keep in touch with the Chapter if there are unable to attend meetings.

Our Chapter has become a very active medium Chapter in TREA, winning many awards for our Newsletter, Website Award, 2012 Medium Chapter President Award for the Year to Louis Arana, individual awards for some of our Board of Director members, National President's Award (1996-1997) to Juanita Anspach. We have delegates that attend the national convention every year and return to our Chapter with all the latest information to inform our members of what is



going on in Washington and around the country.

### **LEONARD BLACK 1ST VP TREA CHAPTER 58**

TAMPA BAY - The Tampa Bay Lightning honored Leonard Black as the 22nd Lightning Community Hero of the year during the first period of the game against the Montreal Canadians. Black, who received a \$50,000 donation from the Lightning Foundation and the Lightning Community Heroes program, will donate the money to Honor Flight West Central Florida.

An American war hero, Black served the United States military for more than 25 years, defending the country during World War II. After losing his son at the age of 24, he was inspired to help serve other people. His wife of 54 years also suffers from Parkinson's disease and made him promise that he would always help others. Black is a crucial church volunteer distributing food to 28 families across the Tampa Bay area. He also coordinates patriotic observances for Hillsborough County.

While in the military, Black attained the highest enlisted rank, Chief Master Sergeant. Being such a devoted military hero, Black saw the need to help the 32,000 World War II veterans living in West Central Florida to get to Washington, D.C. for free to see their memorials built on the National Mall. He has helped organize honor flights for more than 500 local World War II military heroes.

<b>MEMBERSHIP: WHO IS ELIGIBLE</b> <b>Regular Members</b> - Any enlisted person retired, active duty, National Guard or Reserves shall be eligible for regular membership. Any Active Duty Enlisted person with 7 or more years retirement creditable service shall enjoy the privileges of regular membership, including attending conventions, making motions, and holding office. <u>Veteran Members</u> - Any honorably discharged person (as noted on a DD214 or NGB-22) may apply for membership. They may attend convention, vote, and make motions. They must be a member in good standing for three years to eligible to run for National office. The term "regular member" encompasses both charter and life members of TREA. <u>Associate Members</u> -Widows/widowers of members and non-members, who were eligible for membership at the time of their death, are eligible to join TREA: The Enlisted Association as associate members. Associate members are not eligible for life membership. Associate members shall enjoy the privileges of regular membership, except the right to make motions, vote, or hold office.
