# **American Legion Remembrance Site**

The American Legion, the nation's largest veterans service organization, places a high priority on honoring and remembering those who dedicated their lives to keeping our nation safe. A new American Legion web page is packed with stories, photos and videos, and offers visitors the ability to add their own words and images. The Honor and Remembrance web page is now available at www.legion.org/ honor. The page features My Time in Uniform, where you can share your own story, Family Legacy, where you can take pride in a family member's service, and the Sacred Places Database, a listing of more than 1,200 museums, memorials and cemeteries.

# TRICARE FOR LIFE

(What you should know)

Service in Military Facilities: Beneficiaries using TRICARE for Life (TFL) may continue to receive care in Military Treatment Facilities on space available basis. Under the program TRICARE Plus, they may be allowed to enroll in a Military Treatment Facility for primary care. TRICARE Plus is based on local availability.

# Policy Change on Hold

TRICARE has decided to take time to reevaluate its previous decision to change which medications are covered under its prescription drug plan, holding off implementation of the policy change by several months.

"We are working to ensure both excellent and safe care for our beneficiaries and clear communication with our providers and beneficiaries," Express Scripts, TRI-CARE's pharmacy benefits manager, reported on its website.

Last month TRICARE notified about 40,000 beneficiaries that by July 24, it would no longer cover compounded prescription drugs that contain ingredients that are not approved by the Food and Drug Administration.

The policy change will be delayed by 180 days.

# VA Reevaluates Sleep Apnea Ratings

The VA has announced it is studying changes to disability ratings for obstructive sleep apnea, particularly the 50-percent rating being awarded when VA physicians prescribe use of a CPAP, or continuous positive airway pressure machine, for sleep-deprived veterans.

If changes are made the more than 114,000 veterans already drawing compensation for sleep apnea would not see their ratings reduced.

### **MEMBERSHIP: WHO IS ELIGIBLE**

Regular Members - Any enlisted person -- retired, active duty, National Guard or Reserves -- shall be eligible for regular membership. Any Active Duty Enlisted person with 7 or more years retirement creditable service shall enjoy the privileges of regular membership, including attending conventions, making motions, and holding office. <a href="Veteran Members">Veteran Members</a> - Any honorably discharged person (as noted on a DD214 or NGB-22) may apply for membership. They may attend convention, vote, and make motions. They must be a member in good standing for three years to eligible to run for National office. The term "regular member" encompasses both charter and life members of TREA. <a href="Associate Members">Associate Members</a> - Widows/widowers of members and non-members, who were eligible for membership at the time of their death, are eligible to join TREA: The Enlisted Association as associate members. Associate members are not eligible for life membership. Associate members shall enjoy the privileges of regular membership, except the right to make motions, vote, or hold office.


