**Capt. Ian P. Weikel**, 31, of Colorado, died in Balad, Iraq, on April 18 from injuries sustained when an improvised explosive device detonated near his HMMWV during combat operations in Baghdad. He was assigned to the 10th Cavalry Regiment, 1st Brigade Combat Team, 4th Inf Div, Fort Hood, TX.

**PFC Robert J. Settle**, 25, of Owensboro, Ky., died in Taji, Iraq, on April 19, when an improvised explosive device detonated near his HMMWV during combat operations. He was assigned to the 1st Battalion, 66th Armored

Regiment, 1st Brigade Combat Team, 4th Inf Div, Fort Hood, TX.

**Petty Officer 3rd Class Marquies J. Nettles**, 22, of Beaverton, OR, died April 2, when the truck he was riding in rolled over in a flash flood near Al Asad, Iraq. He was assigned to the 1st Combat Logistics Bn, 1st Marine Logistics Group, I Marine Expeditionary Force, Camp Pendleton, CA.

**PFC Patrick A. Tinnell**, 25, of Lake Havasu City, Ariz., died in As Siniyah, Iraq, on April 19, when a vehicle-borne improvised explosive device detonated during a dismantled combat patrol. He was assigned to the 1st Bn, 187th Inf Regiment, 3rd Brigade Combat Team, 101st Airborne Division (Air Assault), Fort Campbell, KY.

**Ian Copeland**, 57, Innovative Music Industry Entrepreneur Popularized New Wave and Punk Rock movements of the 1970s and 1980s, in Los Angeles, May 23, 2006 of melanoma. Copeland was the son of the late Miles Copeland Jr., a former jazz trumpeter turned U.S. intelligence officer. In 1967, at the height of the Vietnam War, he joined the U.S. Army where he was assigned to the 1st Inf Div (the famous "Big Red One") and eventually awarded a Bronze Star Medal, the Good Conduct Medal, four campaign medals, the National Defense Service Medal, the Vietnam Service Medal, the Republic of Vietnam Commendation Medal, and a VBC with palm. He was promoted to Sergeant at the age of 19.

**Sgt. Lea R. Mills**, 21, of Brooksville, FL, April 28 while conducting combat operations against enemy forces in Al Anbar Province, Iraq. He was assigned to the 3rd Assault Amphibian Battalion, 1st Marine Division, I Marine Expeditionary Force, Camp Pendleton, CA

**SP4 J. Adan Garcia**, 20, of Irving, Texas, died on May 27 when his convoy encountered small arms fire received while returning from an explosive ordnance mission. He was assigned to the 1st Brigade Special Troops Battalion, 1st Brigade Combat Team, 10th Mountain Division (Light Infantry), Fort Drum, N.Y.
