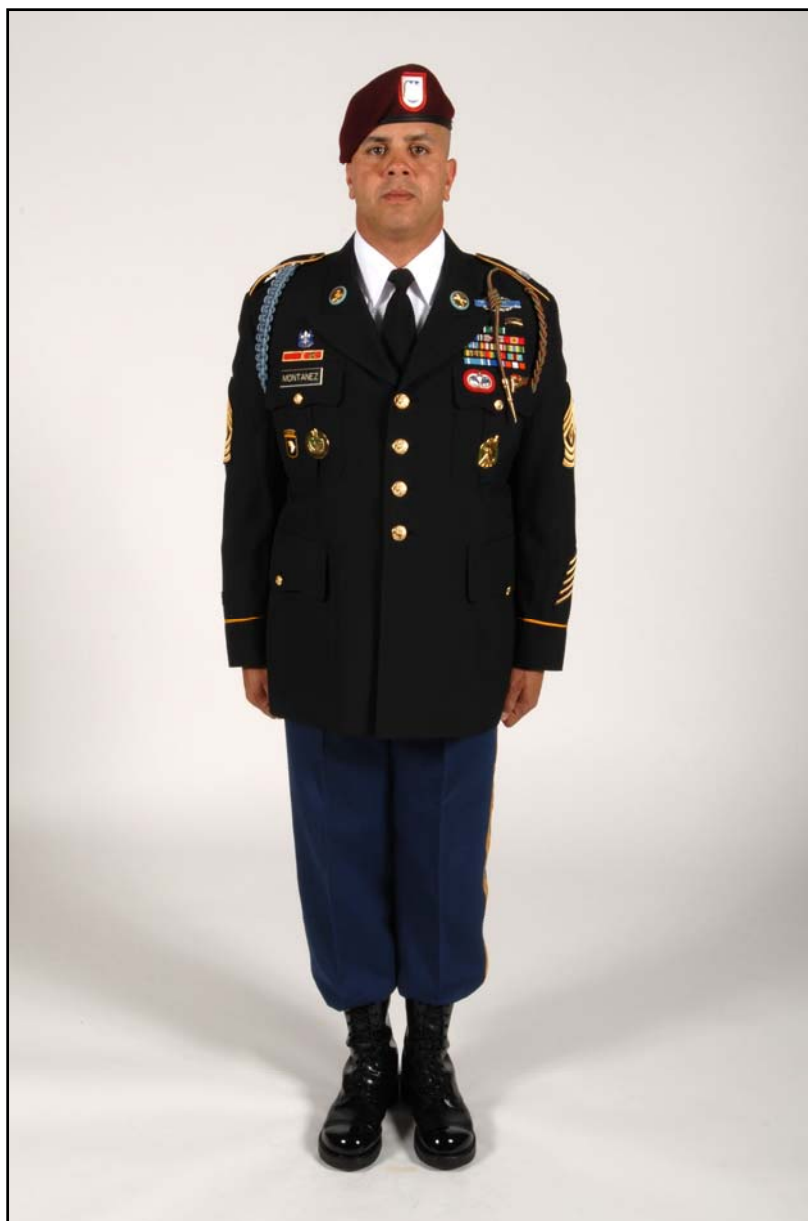
## USMC Dismounted Patrol

## Marine Corps Amputee Returns To Combat Duty



U.S. Marine Corps Cpl. Garrett Jones was deployed to Afghanistan just a year after losing his left leg to a roadside bomb while serving in Iraq as an infantry fighter.

In previous wars, Jones would have received a medical discharge and returned to civilian life, but in the Iraq and Afghanistan conflicts, the Pentagon has made it possible for some amputees to return to combat duty.
